

## Surrey Ladies Order of Merit 2016

The objectives of the order of merit are:

- To promote scratch golf within the county.
- To recognise and reward success.
- The player with the most OOM points at the end of the season will win the Surrey Order of Merit.

### General Rules

Please see the example on page 3 below.

- Players with CONGU handicaps of 9.4 or better are eligible for the SLCGA Order of Merit
- The Order of Merit will follow the calendar year, and playing season. (Most competitions are held between April and September).
- Players will be able to submit scores from Strokeplay, Matchplay and Club Medals.
  - Players will accumulate points in strokeplay events based on their gross score relative to the CSS for that event.
  - Points for matchplay events will be awarded based on the number of wins. (County Championship)
  - Players may accumulate points for their club medals, based on gross score relative to CSS – a total of 5 medal scores can be included. These must be organised events where a CSS has been calculated. Scores can be from any medal competition, and do not have to be from a player's home club. Please note Supplementary Scores do not count.
  - A player's final position in the order of merit will be based on their top 6 events.

- Gross Score and CSS for each round
- Matchplay events – no of wins / made cut (County Championship)

## Example

**A player who competes in strokeplay events will receive points for their gross score relative to the Competition Standard Scratch.**

**Example** A player has a gross score of 77 in the Liphook Scratch Cup. The CSS is 76.  
The Liphook Scratch Cup is a C category event, and  $77 = \text{the CSS} + 1 (76 + 1)$ , so the player gets **27** points.

**For example** a player returning the following scores from club medals, category A events, would be awarded points accordingly

Score 74 - CSS 73 = CSS +1 Cat A=**9** pts

Score 73 - CSS 74 = CSS -1 Cat A=**11** pts

Score 78 - CSS 74 = CSS +4 Cat A =**6** pts

Score 75 - CSS 73 = CSS +2 Cat A = **8** pts

Score 78 - CSS 73 = CSS +5 Cat A = 0 pts

Total Club medal points available: 34 pts. (Maximum of 5 club medals)

## **Matchplay**

**In matchplay events, points are awarded based on wins. A player also will gain points for making the cut in a matchplay event.**

## For example

The County Championship involves both strokeplay and matchplay. A player making the final 16 of the county championship would gain **18** points. Whilst winning the County Championship (ie winning 4 matches, would equate to **105** points.

**Please note club medals will be included if they are one of the top 6 scores**
