All SLCGA members, who are members of Clubs participating in the County Card Scheme, will be entitled to hold a County Card. Clubs 17 other Counties also included in the Scheme. County Cards will be issued at the end of February each year, so members wishing to purchase a County Card may apply through their Club Delegate, before the end of January. However, individual members of a participating Club may apply for a card at any time throughout the year, by contacting the SLCGA Secretary or downloading a form from the website. A charge of £10 will be made for members wishing to participate in the scheme. On payment of the fee and completion of an application form, members will be issued with a County Card. On the Card there will be a label showing their name, their Club's name and their membership number. The card is not transferable. Members will then be entitled to play (ONCE only) at any, or all, of the other participating Clubs, at a reduced green fee. The suggested rate is 50% of the public green fee, or the Members Guest Fee. The card will give a list of Participating Clubs in all Counties.

Members MUST book in advance with the Club Secretary or Professional and confirm the reduced fee payable. The Club concerned fixes the reduced fee. Members should not expect Clubs to accept large parties; only bookings of up to four people are acceptable, at any one time. Members must have their card signed and dated by the Club they are visiting, before play. Members must conform to Club Dress Rules and Regulations. A Handicap certificate may be required.
