### COMPETITION RULES AND INFORMATION

- Scratch Knock Out Competition between representative teams of five players. Home and Away matches will be played in each round until the final round. First round losing teams will automatically be entered into the Hicks Plate.
- Clubs entering must be affiliated to SLCGA and players must have a current Active
- Players may only represent one club in any one year, playing in the Hicks trophy will count for the Hicks Plate.
- All matches will be played from the Red Tee of the day in the first leg and to a conclusion, the number of games won and margin of the win to be recorded on the Results Sheet.
- Clubs will be notified of their opponents by the Secretary, the Team Captain's must then arrange their matches.
- Courtesy of the course is not permitted for practice rounds.
- At least three dates must be offered, one of which must be a weekend and one a week day (Bank Holidays count as weekends). No more than two dates may be offered in any seven day period and at least seven days notice must given for the first date offered. The last day of the fixed round date must be kept free, in case the course is closed on the agreed date. In the event of a 'course closure' on the last day, please contact the Secretary.
- Teams shall play off scratch, but in strict handicap order. If players are of equal playing handicaps The Team Captain may place them in her preferred playing order.
- Any infringement of this rule will lead to disqualification.

- Team Captains must exchange team sheets in playing order with playing handicaps 15 minutes before the first match is due to start. The Team Sheet may not be altered once this information has been exchanged.
- Details of the players' handicaps should only be seen by the Team Captains.
- Should a player fail to be on the tee within 30 minutes after the fixed time for the first match to start, her opponent will be given a walkover. (This will count as 10 points on the Results Sheet).
- In adverse weather conditions a match may be postponed if BOTH Team Captains are in agreement, providing that a suitable replay date is available and can be arranged immediately. Under no circumstances will an extension of the round date be allowed.
- The use of Distance Measuring Devices will be allowed, providing the device does not measure, Temperature, Wind Speed, or Gradient. (See Rule 14 -3)
- A Buggy or Golf Cart may be used by a registered disabled player. A player who is recovering from illness or injury or has a medical condition; may use a buggy providing the player produces a Doctor's letter supporting the medical reason why they require the use of a buggy. This letter must be sent to the Secretary prior to the date of player and will be held in the strictest of confidence.
- Any player authorised to use a Buggy or Golf Cart must check for any restrictions in the 'Buggy Policy' of the Club where they intend to play.
- Caddies will not be allowed until the final round of the competition, which will be in October 2011. Caddies will be allowed to go onto the Greens, but must not delay the pace of play.
- The Captain of the Home Team must send the full results on the official form signed by both Team Captains by either post, fax or e mail, within three days of the match being. Please remember to complete the name of the Club, Venue and Date the match was played on the form. If you play your match the day before the last day of the round, please telephone your result to the Surrey Office, prior to sending the paperwork.
- Up to six temporary greens will be allowed. In the event of ongoing adverse course conditions, please contact the Secretary.
- All matches must start from the first tee in the first leg and be played to a conclusion. In the second leg matches will be played until an overall result is reached. The highest

number of team games won will decide the winners. The overall highest point's margin of the individual wins will count if the match is tied.

- If the teams are still level on games won and the overall points scored from the total margin of wins. The first named players in each team must play 'sudden death' to obtain a result.
- A match which goes beyond the 18<sup>th</sup> hole will score one point for the winner. A disqualification, walkover or conceded match will count as ten points to the winner.
- Any players who play out of handicap order will be disqualified and deemed to have lost their match 10 and 8.
