Competition Rules

- Clubs entering must be affiliated to SLCGA and players must have a current 'Active' CONGU Unified Handicap.
- Players may be substituted after each round. In the final round both players must have competed in at least one previous round of the competition.
- Players may only represent one club in any one year.
- All matches will be played from the 1st Tee and from the Red Tee of the day.
- Matches to be played off half the difference of combined handicaps. All matches to be played over 18 holes and to a conclusion. If continuing past the 18th hole extra holes must be played in the same order and with the same stroke allowance as they were from the start of the match.
- Clubs will be notified of their opponents by the Secretary, the named organiser must then arrange their match.
- The players at the top of the draw will play their first round match at Home. In all future rounds the Secretary will inform players who has a Home draw.
- Courtesy of the course is not permitted for practice rounds.

- At least three dates must be offered, one of which must be a weekend and one a week day (Bank Holidays count as weekends). No more than two dates may be offered in any seven day period and at least seven days notice must be given for the first date offered. The last day of the fixed round date must be kept free, in case the course is closed on the agreed date. In the event of a 'course closure' on the last day, please contact the Secretary.
- If a match has not been played, the players available on the last day of the round will be entitled to a walkover.
- Extensions will not be given unless the course is closed on the last of the round. In which case the Organiser must be contacted. Should an extension be granted the match must be played on the first available day that either course is open.
- Players who have Home advantage, but are unable to offer courtesy of the course to their opponents will be liable to forfeit Home advantage.
- The use of Distance Measuring Devices will be allowed, providing the device does not measure, Temperature, Wind Speed, or Gradient. (See Rule 14 -3)
- A Buggy or Golf Cart may be used by a registered disabled player. A player who is recovering from illness or injury or has a medical condition; may use a buggy providing the player produces a Doctor's letter supporting the medical reason why they require the use of a buggy. This letter must be sent to the Secretary prior to the date of play and will be held in the strictest of confidence.
- Any player authorised to use a Buggy or Golf Cart must check for any restrictions in the 'Buggy Policy' of the Club where they intend to play.
- Caddies will not be allowed until the final round of the competition, which will be in October 2011. Caddies will be allowed to go onto the Greens, but must not delay the pace of play.
- The Semi Final and Final round will be played on a neutral course, which will be arranged by the Secretary.
- Please Telephone, E Mail the result of your match, as soon as possible, after you have played.
