- The competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited, any local rules will be approved by the Championship Committee
- Competition Format: two qualifying 18 holes Medal rounds will be played on the first day, for which one draw will be made. The players returning the lowest 16 scores will qualify for the match play. The match play draw will be made according to the automatic draw and will be posted as soon as possible after the qualifying round has been completed.
- In the event of a tie for the last 16 places and match play stages of the Championship. The result will be decided on count back of the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or last hole in the qualifying round.
- Players must produce a current 'Active' CONGU Handicap Certificate at registration.
- Competitors must be a member of an affiliated Surrey club and not representing another County.
- Handicap Limit 9 for all competitors. Junior and intermediate players must be under 18 or 25 years of age as of 1st January 2011.
- Please inform the organiser if your handicap is reduced, prior to the closing date
- Players under the 18 years of age must complete an SLGA Consent Form.
- No refunds will be given, after the draw has been made.
- All player information will be e mailed.
- If you wish to receive player information by post, please enclose a stamped addressed envelope.
- Play will be from the EWGA /SLCGA Tee Markers.
