The SLCGA Executive Committee has discussed the use of Distance Measuring Devices in SLCGA Competitions. The Committee has agreed that the use of DMD's will be permitted in all SLCGA Ladies and Junior competitions. This rule will take immediate effect for 2010 competitions. This ruling will NOT apply to SLCGA competitions which commenced in 2009. (Derry Cup, Autumn Matchplay, Winter Scratch League, Rothschild Trophy and Monk Plate)

Players must abide by the R&A rule 14.3 concerning the use of DMD's:-

“A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measure distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature etc.), the player is in breach of rule 14.3 for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.”

Please note that individual clubs may have a 'local rule' concerning the use of DMD's.
