WINTER RULES

Clubs may implement from 1st October – 30th April
(CONGU Manual Part Three sub-section 15)

THE FOLLOWING RULE OF GOLF APPLIES. FOR
FURTHER DETAILS SEE APPENDIX 1, PART A, RULE 4.b.

A ball lying on a closely mown area through the green may be lifted without penalty and cleaned. Before lifting the ball, the player must mark its position. Having lifted the ball, he must place it on a spot within six inches of and not nearer the hole than where it originally lay, that is not in a hazard and not on a putting green.

A player may place his ball only once, and it is in play when it has been placed (Rule 20-4) If the ball fails to come to rest on the spot in which it was placed, Rule 20-3d applies. If the ball when placed comes to rest on the spot on which it was placed and it subsequently moves, there is no penalty and the ball must be played as it lies.

If the player fails to mark the position of the ball before lifting it, or moves the ball in any other manner, he incurs a penalty stroke.
